Do You Need Assistance Paying Your Hospital Bill?

If you do not have insurance to cover your hospital bill, and you have low income, you may qualify for help under the Georgia Indigent Care Trust Fund.

This hospital participates in the Georgia Indigent Care Trust Fund. We receive special funding to assist qualified patients with their medical bills. This year we will provide a certain amount of services to patients free or at a reduced charge.

Please review the chart below to see if you qualify for assistance. Your family gross income must be at or below the following Federal Poverty guidelines:

If you think you may be eligible for financial assistance for an account, you may make your request to the Registration Department at the time of service or at the Business Office after services are rendered. Upson Regional Medical Center will make a written conditional or final determination of eligibility for charity care within five business days, and a written notice will be mailed to you.
